Paul Mathieu Lighting

The Paul Mathieu lighting collection, including both the 'Aria' hand-cast, signed bronzes, and 'Madeleine' hand blown Murano glass lamps and chandeliers, were all originally inspired by a commission to design the lighting and liturgical furniture for an 18th century Baroque church in Aix-en-Provence. The collection continues to grow as further pieces are added.

A delicate, honed aesthetic, combined with the choice of simple yet luxurious and beautifully crafted materials, gives these pieces a particular elegance that easily extends their 18th C origins into the present day. The exceptional application of sculptural form to functional objects has resulted in numerous awards. As the collection expands, so yet more iconic pieces emerge.
